ABOUT REFLECTION POINT

Reflection Point helps people work better together. It supports teams, entire organizations and even communities in collaborating more effectively and innovatively. RP uses powerful stories to build bridges, flip perspectives and deepen shared understanding. We start by choosing a short story from literature that surfaces themes relevant to your workplace. Then specially trained facilitators guide small groups (in person or virtually) through reflection and dialogue. We focus on building the five skills every team needs to harness their collective intelligence: listening with humility, asking good questions, challenging assumptions to engage with the perspectives of others, disagreeing with respect but without retribution, and widening the circle of empathy. Reflection Point helps teams reconnect, find their reflection point and work better together.
