FELLOW OPPORTUNITY

Fieldstone Farm is in the process of engaging a cybersecurity consulting firm and is looking for a Fellow to collaborate with the firm, Fieldstone's staff, and the Audit Committee to be the organization's point of contact for the consultant and to coordinate the data gathering and interaction with Fieldstone's staff during the Cyber Risk Assessment.

The Fellow will leverage their professional experience to provide project and program management support, ensure effective communication between stakeholders, including the Board, and assist in translating technical findings into actionable insights for Fieldstone's leadership.

They will play a key role in building Fieldstone's cybersecurity capacity and implementing strategies based on the assessment's recommendations.

The fellow does not need to be a cybersecurity expert; however, an individual with knowledge of information technology and/or risk management would be preferred. The Fellow will represent Fieldstone's staff to the consulting firm.

Good business acumen would also be preferred, and the ability to translate technical risks into prioritized business initiatives that can be communicated to the Board and Executive Staff are the desired skills.

Cyber Security Fellow Role

- Act as Fieldstone Farm point person/representative for the engagement Consulting team
- Participate in an engagement/project kick-off meeting.
- Coordinate data gathering requirements through Fieldstone's Chief Development Officer.
- Ensure timely data gathering and meeting requests by the consulting firm.
- Coordinate project status reports with the Fieldstone executive staff.
- Interface with the Audit Committee on the consultant's initial findings.
- Facilitate a board-level presentation on the recommendations.
- Help prioritize any required remediation activities.
- Act as project lead for any ongoing remediation efforts.
